Some of them live at the refuge camps , others at downtown Reynosa. We have two churches, one inside the shelter and other outside.

From 2021 God called me to serve migrants by helping with food, clothing and food. Because of COVID we had over 50,000 people from Central and South America, Europe, Africa and Haiti.

The vision was focused on minister their lives and provide humanitarian help.

On April 2022, the team and I started the church Mercy Without Borders. Where hundreds of Haitian people attended to sing, pray and listen God's Word in their native languages Creol (African dialect mixed with french).

Till now, we have ministered to thousands of Haitian migrants thru the church and ministry of mercy. The help is given free and no matter their religion. Medical and housing support is also one of the ways we bless them.
